*Be sure you know the condition of your flocks,

As a City Group Leader, your win is to help each person in your group take on step in their walk with God. So how do you measure if group members are taking one step?

Ask! Make it a part of your discussion whether in a group setting or individually. Here are some great questions to guide your conversation:

- How did you get connected to this City Group?
- Do you attend The City Church?
- What brought you to The City Church?
- Have you ever been a part of a City Group before?
- What do you feel like God has been doing in your life lately?
- Have you ever been to an All-Church Prayer?
- What areas of your faith are you hoping to grow in the coming months?
- What are you focused on in your life right now?
- Have you been through the City Church's Grow Classes? Do you remember what your personality type is or what your spiritual gifts are?
- Have you ever served on The Team?
- How can I pray for you?

What are some next steps I can share with my group members?

Everyone in your group will be at different places spiritually. The vision of helping "take one step" is not to get them to do everything at once, it's to help identify where they currently are spiritually and offer a practical next step to help them grow.

- Invite them to attend a Sunday Service with you.
- Share a personal story and what God has been teaching you.
- Invite them to All Church Prayer on Thursdays.
- Share how the Grow Classes can help them discover their purpose and invite them to attend.
- Invite them to consider being water baptized.
- Share how you find time regularly to pray, worship, and read God's Word and encourage them to make their own plan for time with God.
- Talk to them about our Fresh Start Groups that will help them develop a strong Biblical foundation in their relationship with God.
- If they are ready to receive Christ, offer to pray with them.
